VISIT TO NANT-Y-BEDD GARDENS

27TH AUGUST 2024

Following the interesting talk last week by Sue Mabberley, a visit to Nant-y-Bedd gardens has been arranged and we will have exclusive use to the gardens.

However, due to parking restrictions, we are only able to take 10 cars so this will be on a “car share” basis and the number of visitors is restricted to 30 people.

Therefore, bookings for this visit will be on a “first come” basis.

The cost of the visit is £8.50 per member.

Members will need to arrive by 11.00 am for a welcome talk.

Seating in the garden room is restricted to 20 so if our party is larger than this, we may have to have 2 sittings – 11.30 am and 3.00 pm – for refreshments.

If refreshments are required, the charge is £3.50 (tea/coffee and cake) per member.

You are free to take a picnic and there are some covered areas in the garden should the weather be a little inclement!

Sue suggests that you DO NOT follow satnav or google to find the gardens and these are her directions:

From the HEREFORD area take the A465 Hereford to Abergavenny road and turn off into LLANFIHANGEL CRUCORNEY.

By the Skirrid Inn (in Llanfihangel Crucorney) turn down the hill (following signs for Llanthony), bear left at the bottom of the hill and continue for about a mile, passing under a railway bridge (13'6" height limit). Turn left at the signpost for Fforest Coal Pit, Partrishow and Llanbedr.

After a mile and a half, you will arrive at Five Ways junction. Take the road to the Grwyne Fawr Reservoir, passing the (Grade II listed) grey telephone box and continue over the river for 4.5 miles.

Sue says if you trust more modern methods, you can get there using **library.skies.model** on What3Words

The house is on the left hand side next to a small red Post Box. Please park on the right hand side alongside the black roofed barn.
